

Refraction and Contact Lens Evaluation Fees and Information

Refraction is the portion of your examination that determines whether or not you need glasses. It is an essential part of a thorough eye examination. The fee is **\$65**.

Most insurance companies, including Medicare, **DO NOT COVER** services that they consider part of a routine eye exam. Non-covered services are charged to the patient.

If you are a **current contact lens wearer** and would like an updated prescription with the same lens type, you will have to pay an additional **\$50** evaluation fee. If you would rather not have this service performed, please tell one of our staff members.
